 Shelby County / Arred into this the 30th day of
 July a.d. 1879 Between Asa Goodwin and Emily Goodwin
 husband and wife of the first part and Jas. M. Good-
 win of the second part all of the State and county
 aforesaid, Witnesseth that the said parties of the
 first part for and in consideration of the sum
 of Two Hundred Dollars to them in hand paid
 by the parties of the second part, the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained
 and sold and conveyed unto the party of the
 second part the following tract of land lying
 in Shelby County & State of Alabama, to-wit:-
 S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ section 14 also SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the
 NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 15, Township 19, Range one East, con-
 taining ninety acres more or less. To have and
 to hold, to the parties of the second part his
 heirs and assigns forever and we do cove-
 ant with the party of the second part that
 we are lawfully seized of and have a
 good right to sell and convey said
 land and premises that we ourselves
 our heirs and assigns and legal rep-
 resentatives will warrant and defend and
 defend, to title to said land and prem-
 ises to the party of the second part his
 heirs and assigns and legal represen-
 tatives against the lawful claims of all
 persons in law or in Equity and against
 the government of the United States, in
 witness whereof we have hereunto set our
 Hands & Seals the day and date above written

 Emily Goodwin (L.S.)
