 the first part and James H. Huron and Hardy S. Nelson
 partners using the firm name of Huron & Nelson of
 the second part all of the County and State aforesaid
 witnesseth that said party of the first part for and
 in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars
 to her in hand paid by the said parties of the second
 part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has
 bargained and sold and by these presents does grant
 bargain sell and convey unto said parties of the second
 part the following described house and lot in the
 town of Columbiana in said County being the store
 house and lot described as lot No. 1 of the lots bought
 of Rushing estate lying in the town of Columbiana
 North and opposite the Odd Fellows Hall lying on
 the corner North of Kymulga Road leading to Tuscaloosa
 west of the road running from the Court House North
 east of lots soed William Baker it being the store
 house and lot now occupied by said Huron & Nelson
 10th and 11th to said parties of the second part
 and to their heirs and assigns forever together with

all the rights and tenements therunto belonging and
 said party of the first part conveys with said parties:
 of the second part that she is lawfully seized and
 possessed of said house and lot except as conveyed in
 deed of trust to Wm T. Maud of Dec-10th 1868 and which
 said deed of trust is to be paid and satisfied by said
 Human & Nelson and that she will forever warrant
 and defend the title to the same except as aforesaid
 from all and every person claiming under her.
