situated in Shelby County Ala To-wit, Beginning near the Bayou at the South end of
the Oak Ridge, from thence in an Eastward direction along the front of said Ridge to
the farm road of L. D. West from thence along the West side of said road in
a Northward direction to the corner of said West place, thence in a straight
line to his lots line, thence along said line to the corner, thence West to
the top of the mountain, thence along the top of said Mountain to the
beginning point part in S. 6 1/4 S. 7 1/4 Sec 3, and part in East 1/2 of N. 7 1/4
