 proved March 2nd, 1907, have granted, bargained and sold,
 and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain sell and
 Convey unto the State of Alabama, for the benefit of School
 District no. 33 of Shelby County, Alabama, the following de-
 scribed Real Estate situated in the County of Shelby and
 State of Alabama, to wit: Two acres described as follows
 Commencing at the South West Corner of the Bethel Church
 lot running West across the Tuscaloosa Road 140 yards,
 hence North 70 yards, hence East 140 yards, thence South
 70 yards to beginning point. To have and to hold the
 aforesaided premises to the said State of Alabama for the
 benefit of said school district no. 33 of Shelby County,
 Alabama, forever. And we do Covenant with the said
 State of Alabama for the benefit of said school district
