 No. 34220. } To all to whom these Presents shall come greeting;
 Whereas Elizabeth Henderson of Shelby County, Alabama
 has deposited in the General Land Office of the United
 State, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at
 Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment has
 been made by the said Elizabeth Henderson, according to the
 provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820,
 entitled "an Act making further provision for the sale
 of the Public Lands" for the South East quarter of the
 North West quarter of Section Three, in Township Twenty-
 one of Range Four West in the District of lands subject
 to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing Forty acres
 and ten and a half hundredths of an acre, accord-
 ing to the Official plat of the Survey of the said Land,
 returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor
 General which said tract has been purchased by the
 said Elizabeth Henderson. Now know ye, That the United
 States of America, in consideration of the premises, and
 in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in
 such cases made and provided, Have given and granted
 and by these Presents do give and grant unto the
 said Elizabeth Henderson, and to her heirs, the
 said tract above described; To have and to hold

the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Elizabeth Anderson and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof, I, James Buchanan, President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the first day of June, in the year of our Lord One Thousand, eight hundred and fifty eight, and of the Independence of the United States the Eighty-second.


