Shelby County, } this the 30th day of April A. D. 1910, by
and between L. N. Nabors who is an unmarried male, party
of the first part, and M. Della Lashawn, party of the second
part. It witnesseth: That for and in Consideration of the sum
of four hundred and three $\frac{1}{10}$ dollars in hand paid
to the party of the first part by the party of the second part,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the party of
the first part has granted, bargained and sold, and
does by these presents grant, Bargain sell and Convey
unto the said party of the second part the following
described pieces, parcels or lots of land situated, lying
and being in the town of Aldmont, Shelby County, Ala.,
and more particularly described as follows: Lots
numbers eight (8) nine (9) ten (10), eleven (11) twelve (2),
thirteen (13) and fourteen (14), in Block three (3) ac-
cording to a survey and map of said town of
Aldmont made by B. L. Miller, C. E., for said L. N.
Nabors, which said map is dated September 14th, 1908,
and is recorded in the Office of the Probate Judge of
said County, said lots being in the east half of the north
west quarter of section twenty, Township twenty two Range
three West. To have and to hold unto the said party of
the second part to gather with all and singular the
buildings, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging
or for any wise appertaining to her, the said
party of the second part her heirs and assigns, in
fee simple forever. And the party of the first part pre-
sents to and Conveys with the said party of the
second part that he is seized of an undivided interest
in fee simple, in and to the above described property,
and has a good right to sell and Convey the same;
that said property is free from any and all liens, taxes and
incumbrances, whatsoever; and that he, the said party

of the first part, will warrant and prosecute defend the said party
by the second part, in the quiet and peaceable possession of the
same, against the lawful claims or demands of any person or
persons whomsoever.
