

The State of Alabama, Whereas, an execution issued Shelby County from the Circuit - of Shelby County, against Ella Ozley in favor of J. W. Ozley and J. H. Ozley on a judgement rendered in said Court, on the 4th day of April 1910 for the sum of One hundred and forty two and 10/100 Dollars, costs of suit, which said execution came into my hands as Sheriff of said County on the 17th day of May 1910, to execute and return according to law, by virtue of which said execution, I did, as Sheriff aforesaid levy upon the following as the property of the said Ella Ozley, to-wit: One house and lot, in the town of Colera, Shelby County, Alabama, on Montgomery Avenue, described as follows; - Bounded on the East by Montgomery Avenue, on the North by the Alexander lot, on the West by the Piggen lot on the South by the Baronsen lot, being the house and lot on which Green Collins now resides.

of which said levy then and there notice was given the defendant personally, and after giving notice of the time, place and terms of sale by advertisement once a week for three successive weeks in the Peoples Advocate a newspaper published in the town of Columbia, in said County, and also by giving thirty days previous notice of the time, place and terms of sale by posting advertisement thereof at the Court House door of said County, said property so levied on was offered for sale at the Court House door of said County, between the legal hours of sale, on the 3rd Monday in August 1910 that being the 18th day of Aug. 1910, at which said sale John W. Ozley became the purchaser of said property so levied on as aforesaid, for the sum of One hundred and fifty and 05/100 Dollars, he being the highest, best and last bidder for the same.

Now, Therefore, Know all men By These Presents,
That in pursuance of the premises, for and in
consideration of the said sum of one hundred
and fifty and 00/100 Dollars, to me in hand paid
by the said John W. Ozley the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged, I, H. M. Norris,
as Sheriff of said County, do hereby sell, convey,
transfer and set over to the said John W.
Ozley all the title, interest and claim which
the said Ella Ozley had, held and owned
in and to the foregoing described premises
as fully and completely, in all respects, as
I might, could or ought to convey the same,
under and by virtue of the power and au-
thority vested in me in the premises and by
the statutes for such cases provided. To have
and to hold unto the said John W. Ozley,
his heirs and assigns forever.
