The application of Mrs Maggie Smith Walker for the removal of the disabilities of non-age of Edith Smith coming on to be heard on this day, being the day appointed by a former order of this Court for hearing the same, and it appearing that the said Edith Smith has accepted service of said petition and waived service thereof by the Sheriff, and it appearing that the evidence introduced has been taken by affidavits as required by order of this Court and there is on file the affidavits of Mrs Maggie Smith Walker, L. C. Abbott and C. H. Bowles, and from this evidence adduced it appears to the Court that the facts stated in said petition are true, and that said Edith Smith is a minor over the age of eighteen years and resides with her mother, the petitioner, in this County, and that it is to her interest to have her disabilities removed. It is therefore ordered, decreed and adjudged by the Court that it is to the interest of said minor to have her disabilities removed, and that such disabilities of minority are hereby removed, and that she is invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and perform all acts which such minor could lawfully do if twenty-one years of age.
