Witnesseth; That the said parties of the first
port for and in consideration of the sum of
Two Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty
One Dollars to them in hand paid

by the said party of the second part at and before the delivery hereof the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have this day granted, Borgouin, and Sold and do by these presents Grant, Borgouin, Bell and Convey unto the said party of the second part the following lot of land lying and being in Shelby County, Alabama and described as follows, to-wit: The West half of the north east quarter and the south east half of the north west quarter and a small part of the West half of the North West Quarter of Section nine, township twenty four, range twelve east, reserving and less four lots, one of five acres owned by Bob Shortridge, one of one acre owned by Harding, one of one acre owned by John Dockery and one of two acres owned by Melvin Hill, also less forty-three and $\frac{3}{4}$ acres sold to J.H. Little, a plat of which is attached to the deed from C.H. Hooper and others to J.S. O'Gwin and J.M. O'Gwin, containing one hundred and twenty and $\frac{3}{4}$ acres, more or less.

Together with all and singular the rights, privileges immunities, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining.

To have and to hold unto the said party of the second part and unto his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple.

And the said parties of the first part does hereby covenant with the said party of the second part and unto his heirs and assigns forever that the above described land is not and never has been the homestead of any of the parties of the first part.
