Buffington, Frank J. Smith, William C. Bibb, George N. Gilmer, Alfred H. Moses and Presley W. Donelson, and to their heirs and assigns forever. *On testimony whereof,*

J. Andrew Johnson, President of the United States of America, having caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be affixed.
