

This Indenture, made and entered into this
the 1st day of October A.D. 1910 by and between
N. P. Farley & Daisy Farley, his wife and
W. G. Parker and Est. Parker, his wife of
the first part, and Cecil Broyne of the
County of Talladega and State of Alabama,
of the second part, Witnesseth; That
the said N. P. Farley — Farley,
W. G. Parker and Parker for
and in Consideration of the sum
of Five hundred four & $\frac{6}{100}$ Dollars,
to them in hand paid by the Party of
the second part, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, ha — This
day granted, bargained, sold, aliened,
enfeoffed and conveyed, and by these

present do grant, bargain, sell, exchange and convey to the said Cecil Browne; one undivided one third interest in & to all those certain tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

That certain Lot on which is situated a Brick Store & which is bounded by a line commencing at a point 25 feet south of the North East corner of Lot number 1 in Block No. 16 according to the plan of survey of the town of Alkmight as made by Harvey Surveyor & Cecil Browne et als owner & which is on record in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Ala., running thence along the West boundary line of First Ave. a distance of 35 ft. thence West 100 feet, thence North 25 ft & thence East 100 ft. to Point of beginning; also Lots numbers 5, 20, 21, 22, 23, & 24 in said Block 16; also a strip of land 10 feet wide off the East side of lot number 4 in said Block 16, subject to alley privileges heretofore granted & conveyed. To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land, together with the tenements and appurtenances thereto belonging, or otherwise appertaining unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said W. L. Farley & W. L. Parker of the first part, for themselves, heirs, executors, and administrators, do warrant and will forever defend, the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns,

from and against themselves, and all and
every person claiming or holding under them,
the said party of the first part, and
against the lawful title, claim or demand
of all and every person whatsoever claiming
or holding by, from or under the Doc-
ument of the United States.
