 (\$400⁰⁰) in hand paid by said party of the second part
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said
 parties of the first part have granted, bargained and
 sold and do by these presents grant, bargain, sell
 and convey unto said party of the second part
 the following described real estate lying and being
 in said County and State to-wit: all that part of the
 East half of South West quarter of Section Four (4)
 Township Twenty four (24) Range Twelve (12) East
 which lies North and West of Shoal Creek as said
 Creek now runs, the same being all that part of
 the farm known as the "Steele Place" which lies
 North and West of said Shoal Creek as said Creek
 now runs, containing twenty acres more or less.
 To have and to hold together with all the rights,
 privileges, tenements and hereditaments thereto
 belonging or appertaining unto said party of the
 second part his heirs and assigns forever, and
 said parties of the first part hereby Covenant
 with said party of the second part that they are
 lawfully seized in fee simple of said real estate
 that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of said real
 estate, that they have a good right to sell and convey
 the same and that they will warrant and defend
 the title to the same to said party of the second
 part his heirs and assigns against the lawful
 claims or demands of any and all persons
 either at law or in equity.
