together with all and singular the tenements and ap-
pertaining thereto, belonging or in any wise apper-
taining.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. Henry Wallon

and the said J. D. Garrell, and his heirs and assigns, forever, and do hereby covenant for the use and benefit of J. Henry Wallon and his heirs and assigns, that at the time of the execution of this instrument, there is no debt and no encumbrance of any kind, lawfully seized in fee simple of spid premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, that he has a good-right to sell and convey the said property, that he will, and shall warrant and defend the same to said J.
