The fourth part of Lot 6 as shown by Dares Plat of the town of Calera in said County, and changed by J.R. Hardy to conform to plat made in deed from said Hardy to J.W. Fields; said lot fronting forty one and one half feet on the west side of Montgomery Avenue and one hundred and fifty six feet on the north side of Sullivan Street described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the west side of Montgomery Avenue and the north side of Sullivan Street at iron stake; thence forty one and a half feet northwardly along the west side of Montgomery Avenue; thence a little north of parallel with Sullivan Street one hundred and fifty feet; thence thirty eight feet south of west along fourth line of Calover Street to lot; thence in a southerly direction forty four feet to Sullivan Street; thence along the north side of Sullivan Street one hundred and fifty six feet to the beginning, and being the same property conveyed to O.M.
