E. 1/4 of Section 14, Township 20 South Range 3 West, thence due East along the forty boundary lines 13 1/4 8 1/100 yards to the North East Corner of the N. E. 1/4 of the S. W. 1/4 Section 14, thence 200 yards due South along the forty line, thence due West 13 1/4 8 1/100 yards to the quarter section line between the S. E. 1/4 and S. W. 1/4 of Section 14, thence 200 yards due North to the point of commencement; also any additional tract or land or about 1/2 acres, adjoining the West end of the above described tract if it bounded on the North by the "Leonard place", on the East by the Caloosa road and the "Miller tract" and on the South East by the "Goodson Children tract" and on the West by the "James Lacy home place" the whole of the above described lands containing 58 1/2 acres more or less - The above mentioned lands are described in a map accompanying this deed; excepting and reserving to our own use and benefit the full possession use and all benefits rents and profits therefrom accruing from our said lands during the natural life of both or either of us - after the death of either grantor his or her co-tenant of the above mentioned lands to begin full force and effect.
