by the party of the second part the Receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged have given,  
granted, bargained and sold and by these  
presents do give, Grant, Bargain, and  
Sell unto the said party of the second  
part his heirs and assigns forever a certain  
tract or parcel of land, viz: the  $\frac{1}{2}$  of  $\frac{1}{4}$  of  
and the  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  and the  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 20, Township 2<sup>d</sup>, Range 2  
West together with all and singular the  
appurtenances hereditaments and Rights in  
any wise appertaining unto the said J.B. E.  
Odham his heirs and assigns forever and we  
the said parties of the first part for our  
Selves do warrant and will ever defend the  
right and title to the above described prem-  
ises from and against the claim of every per-  
son or persons whomsoever their names where-  
of us the said parties of the first part have
