of September A.D. 1910 by and between Cecil Brownie and

second part, witnesseth; That the said Cecil Brownie
and Dorothy B. Brownie for and in consideration of the
sum of Two Hundred and Sixty five & no/100 dollars,
to them in hand paid by the party of the second part,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have this
day granted bargained sold, aliened dispossessed and com-
muted and by these presents do grant, bargain sell, enfranchise
and convey to the said D.B. Evans all that certain tract
or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Shelby
and State of Alabama, and more particularly described
as follows to wit: The North half of lots numbers 13,
14-15-16-17-18 and 19 in Block 23, according
to the map and plan of survey of the town of

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deed as made by F. A. Harvey Surveyor, and Cecil Brown
and others as proprietors and recorded in the Office of the
Probate Judge of Shelby County Alabama, in Book of Land
Deeds Vol # - on page - To have and to hold the
above described tract or parcels of land, together with fu-
llementments and appurtenances thereto belonging. And the
said Cecil Brown and Sara B. Brodhead & the first
part for themselves, heirs executors and administrators
do warrant and will forever defend the estate to the
above described and hereby granted premises unto the
said party of the second part his heirs and assigns,
from and against themselves, and all and every person
claiming or holding under them the said party of the
first part and against the lawful title, claim or
demand of all and every person whomsoever claiming
or holding by from or under the Government of the
United States!
