Wheras: William v. Prentice of Shelby County Alabama,
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United
States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at
this place, whereby it appears that full payment has
been made by the said William v. Prentice, according
to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of
April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further Provision
for the Sale of the Public Lands" for the North East
quarter of the South East quarter of Section Thirtieth in
Township Twenty-one of Range Four East in the
District of lands subject to Sale at Tuscaloosa City,
containing forty acres and fifty-eight and a half acres
or about one acre, according to the Official Plat of
the Survey of the said lands returned to the General
Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract
has been purchased by the said William v. Prentice.

Now Know ye That the United States of America, in Consideration
 of the Precedents and in Conformity with the several acts of
 Congress in such Case made by and granted unto the said
 Granted, and by these presents Do Give and Grant unto the
 said William L. Prentice, and to his heirs, the said tract
 above described: To Have and to Hold the same together with
 all the rights, privileges immunitiess and appurtenances
 of what ever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said
 William L. Prentice, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
 In Testimony Whereof I, Millard Fillmore, President of the
 United States of America, have caused these letters to be made
 Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be
 hereunto affixed.

 eight hundred and fifty-six, and of the Independence
 of the United States, the forty-sixth.
