 in Consideration of the sum of One hundred and Twenty  
 five dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged have this day bargained,  
 granted, sold, aliented and transferred and Conveyed  
 and by these presents do give grant bargain, sell for  
 fross and Convey to the said George Moore all that  
 certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in  
 the County of Shelby and State of Alabama, and known  
 and distinguished in the plan of Survey of said  
 State as the N. E  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N. E  $\frac{1}{4}$  and a part of S. E  $\frac{1}{4}$  of N. E  $\frac{1}{4}$   
 Section 25 Township 20, Range 2 West containing forty  
 acres more or less, two and Sixty rods the  
 said part of the North West corner of North East  
 of North East, of which is to be paid off of the S. E  $\frac{1}{4}$   
 of N. E  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the North end. To have and to hold  
 the above described tract or parcel of land together  
 with the fixtures and appurtenances hereunto  
 belonging, or in any wise appertaining unto the  
 said George Moore, his heirs and assigns forever  
 And the said John H. Streety and Martha Streety do  
 their heirs, executors and administrators do warrant  
 and will, his heirs and assigns from and against  
 all and every person or persons claiming for  
 holding under them the said party of the first part  
 and also against the lawful title, claim or demands  
 of all and every person or persons who or may  
 claiming or holding by from or under the go-  
 vernment of the United States.
