 and the North half of North East quarter, and the
 North East fourth of North West fourth of Section Twenty

 and to hold said land and premises with the appur-
 tenances thereto belonging unto them the said Joseph
 Doris his heirs and assigns forever we the said
 party of the first part do Covenant to and with the
 said party of the second part that we are lawfully
 seized of the premises aforesaid and that we will
 forever warrant and defend title in fee simple to
 the premises aforesaid.
