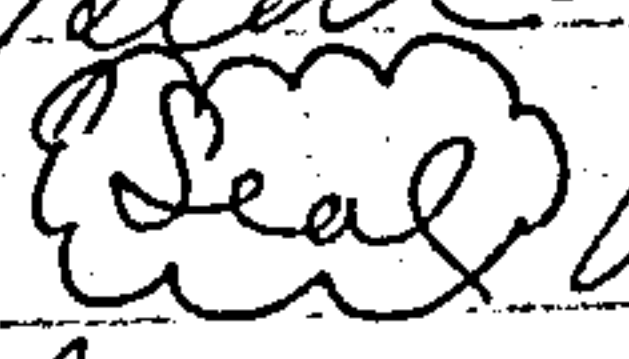
In the matter of the petition of George R. Glynn for Leola Glynn

thereof, it is ordered adjudged and decreed by the court
that Leola Glynn a minor who is over the age of eighteen years
be and is relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and she is rest-
ed with the power to sue and be sued contract and be con-
tracted with to buy, sell and convey real estate generally to do
and perform all acts which said minor could do if twenty
one years of age. It is further decreed that the said George
R. Glynn pay the costs of this proceeding, for which execution
may be issued.
