 my store at home about one and one half miles west of Harpers-  
 ville, Alabama, and all of said goods in said store embraced in  
 said stack of goods of any and all descriptions whatsoever;  
 All of my crop of corn now in the field on the 45 acres of land  
 now owned by me in Shelby County Alabama, known as the Henry  
 Prince place; About to wit; 1200 bundles of fodder now in my  
 barn and owned by me at my store near said Harpersville as  
 above stated; 1 one horse Studebaker wagon and one auto  
 seat buggy both of which are now owned by me;  
 To have and to hold to the said Martha Gill, her executors  
 administrators and assigns forever, and I the said W. H. Gill  
 do hereby covenant and warrant for myself, my heirs, exe-  
 cutors and administrators to and with the said Martha  
 Gill, that the above property is my own and that I have a  
 good right to convey the same and that it is free from  
 all incumbrances, and that I will forever warrant and

defend the title to said property against the lawful claims of all and every person and persons whatsoever.
