 1 East, and also the East half of the Northeast quarter of section No. 34 in
 Township No. 17 of Range No. 1 East, containing one hundred and Ninety six
 acres and Ninety one 1/2 more or less for the consideration of three hun-
 dred dollars in hand paid, and we the party of the first part, do this
 day give, grant, release and convey to the party of the second part as
 above mentioned, and we the parties of the first part do bind ourselves
 our heirs executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and defend
 the right and title from all and every person lawfully claiming
 the same under any pretention whatever, to the party of the second
 part, his heirs executors and administrators and assigns forever.
