This indenture, made
and entered into this 25 day December A. D. 1878, between
Henry Blackbury and Deedie Blackbury husband and
wife, of the first part, and Jesse Blackbury of the second
part, witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for

and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars is then in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, the following described land lying in Shelby County and State of Alabama. To wit:

The N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and two acres off the N $\frac{1}{2}$ corner of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36 in Township 14 of Range one west containing 8 2 acres more or less.

We have and do hold to said second party his heirs and assigns forever, the above described and hereby granted lands and premises and the said parties of the first part, husband and wife, hereby covenant with the said party of the second part that they are lawfully seized of and have a good right to sell and convey said land, and hereby bind themselves, their heirs and legal representatives forever, to warrant and defend the title to said land and premises to the said party of the second part, his heirs, assigns and legal representatives, against the claim of all and every person in law or equity, and against the Government of the United States.
