

The State of Alabama Knows all men by these presents, That Whereas:  
 Shelby County      On the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 1910, J. N. Ozley and A. A.  
 Ozley obtained a judgment in the Circuit Court of Shelby County  
 Alabama, against Ella Ozley for the sum of One hundred forty  
 two and 10/100 Dollars;

And whereas an execution was issued on said judgment directed  
 to the Sheriff of Shelby County and placed in the hands of said Sheriff  
 on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1910 and the said Sheriff under and by virtue  
 of said execution levied on the following property of the said  
 Ella Ozley to wit: One house and lot in the town of Calera, Shelby  
 County, Alabama on Montgomery Avenue, described as follows: Bounded  
 on the East by Montgomery Avenue, on the North by the Alexander  
 lot on the West by the Pilgreen lot, on the South by the Airsonson lot  
 being the house and lot on which Green Collins now resides;

And whereas under and by virtue of said execution and  
 levy, the said Sheriff on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 1910 sold said  
 above described property at Sheriff's sale and the said J. N. Ozley  
 became the purchaser of said property at said sale for the  
 sum of one hundred fifty and 05/100 Dollars, and H. M. Harris  
 the said Sheriff executed to said J. N. Ozley a Sheriff's deed to  
 said above described property on said 18<sup>th</sup> day of August for  
 the said sum of One hundred fifty and 05/100.

And whereas, the said Ella Ozley desiring to redeem said property within two years, as allowed by law, has made a written demand on the said J. N. Ozley demanding to make a written statement to her of the debt and all lawful charges claimed by him under and by virtue of said above described execution sale and in compliance with said demand the said J. N. Ozley has made said written statement to said Ella Ozley claiming the sum of Two hundred thirty three and  $73/100$  Dollars as said debt and lawful charges; Now therefore in consideration of the premises above set forth, and in further consideration of the sum of Two hundred thirty three and  $73/100$  to me in hand paid by the said Ella Ozley, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we the said J. N. Ozley and his wife A. A. Ozley do grant bargain sell and convey to the said Ella Ozley all the right title and interest we acquired under and by virtue of said Sheriff's deed, in and to the following described real property to wit:

One house and lot in the town of Calera, Shelby County, Alabama on Montgomery Avenue, described as follows: Bounded on the East by Montgomery Avenue, on the North by the Alexander lot, on the West by the Odgreen lot, on the South by the Aaronson lot, being the house and lot on which Green Collins resided on the 18th of August 1910. To have and to hold to the said Ella Ozley, her heirs and assigns forever.
