The South half of the South west fourth of Section Two in Township (18)  
 eighteen South or Range one East of Huntsville Meridian in  
 Shelby County, Alabama, containing (80) eighty acres more or less

situated in Shelby County, Alabama.  
 TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said Charles Whistler and his  
heirs and assigns, forever. And we do for ourselves and our heirs, executors and  
administrators covenant with said Charles Whistler and his
