 said Grantors have bargained and sold and by these pres-
 ents do grant and Convey unto said Grantee certain
 real property in said County and State described as follows:
 a part of the tract of land conveyed by W. H. Page by deed
 bearing date 3rd day November 1863 to the children
 and heirs at law of B. H. Page deceased and which is
 recorded in Deed Book D. Page 82-6 and afterwards
 conveyed by Act of gift release and relinquishment by
 the said children and heirs to the said Sam Page and
 which is recorded in the Probate Office of said County
 in Book P and more particularly described as fol-
 lows, Sixty acres off of the South end of the 127 or 128
 acres Conveyed by said Page and wife, deed, being
 sixty acres off the South end of the E 1/2 of the S. W 1/4
 and of that part of the N 1/2 of the S. W 1/4 of Section 14 Township
 21 Range 1 West Conveyed as stated by said Page and
