do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said L. C. Clifton

The South East 1/4 of the South West 1/4 of Section 23 Township 18 S. Range 2 East  
containing forty (40) acres more or less, but the grantors do hereby expressly  
and specifically reserve unto themselves his heirs and assigns all of the  
mineral rights in said land, and the right to dig mineral from said  
land and to operate mines thereon and therewith full privileges of ingress  
and egress over said land by means of roadways from ways or other means  
incidental or necessary to the digging of said minerals from said land

situated in Shelby County, Alabama
