

This Indenture made and entered into this the 15 day of August A.D. 1911 by and between H.B. Lane and E.C. Lane of the first part and D.B. Evans + R.S. Huff as deacons of the first Baptist Church of Arkright + their successors in office of the county of Shelby and State of Alabama of the second part.

Witnesseth that the said H.B. Lane + E.C. Lane Two hundred and sixty five and no Dollars to them in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. For this day granted, bargained sold, aliened, enfeoffed and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell enfeoff and convey to the said D.B. Evans + R.S. Huff as deacons as aforesaid + their successors in office all that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of Shelby and State of Alabama and more particularly described as follows to wit: Lots number 9 and 10 in Block number 19 according to the plan of survey of the town of Arkright as the same is plotted and on file in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County Alabama.

To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land with the tenements and appurtenances thereto belonging or otherwise appertaining unto the said party of the second part heirs and assigns forever. And the said H.B. Lane and E.C. Lane of the first part for themselves, heirs, executors and administrators do warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the said party of the second part their successors in office and assigns from and against themselves and all and every person claiming or holding under them, the said party of the first part and against the lawful title, claim or demand of all and

every person whosoever claiming or holding by force or under the Government of the United States.
