we do hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained and
sold, and by these presents do hereby grant bargain, sell
and Convey unto the said Trustees of the Primitive Bap-
tist Church their heirs and assigns the following de-
scribed Real Estate, situated in the County of Shelby and

State of Alabama, to-wit: Beginning where the half section line which runs East and West through the middle of section Two (2) Township Twenty One (21) Range Three (3) West Crosses the Ashville and Montevallo Road thence East along said line Eighty feet (80) ft. Thence in a southerly direction Eighty (80) feet parallel with said Road thence West to the said Ashville and Montevallo Road thence North along said Road to the place of beginning. The said premises shall be held, kept and maintained and used as a place of religious worship. To have and to hold the aforesaid premises to the said Trustees of the Primitive Baptist Church in America, heirs and assigns forever.

And we do covenant with the said Trustees of the Primitive Baptist Church, heirs and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee of the aforesaid premises; that they are free from all encumbrance; that we have a good right to sell and convey the same to said Trustees of the Primitive Baptist Church heirs and assigns, also that we will warrant and defend the premises to the said Trustees of the Primitive Baptist Church, heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
