In Consideration of the appropriation of \$2,000.00 by the Board of Revenue of Shelby County Alabama to be used for obtaining the 1912 State Aid Appropriation for Constructing that part of the road already surveyed beginning at the North Corporate limits of Calera and leading to Pelham, via O'Neal, Longview, Daynes, and Keystone we the following citizens P. C. Bowden, C. L. O'Neal, H. G. Nichols, C. E. Leogard and J. B. Adams build ourselves to pay or to have paid the sum of \$1,000.00 to be expended on this road for repairing the worst places North of where the State Aid portion of the road will be constructed. We reserve the privilege to pay this \$1,000.00 either in Cash or work. That portion which is paid in work will be performed by men and men living in the vicinity of the road and for each days work for man and double for woman we are to get credit for \$3.00 For each man without team we are to be credited with \$1.25 for each days work. It is understood that this \$1,000.00 is to be expended under the supervision of the State Highway Engineer, ourselves and the Shelby County Board of Revenue and at places to be agreed upon from time to time until March 20, 1913. This \$1,000.00 is no addition to the \$8,000.00 already appropriated by Shelby County, the State of Alabama and ourselves making a total of \$17,000.00 to be expended on the road already described.
