 acknowledged, I the said Elizabeth Brandon and
 William W. Brandon the husband of the said Elisa-
 beth Brandon who joins in the execution of this
 deed to enable his said wife to convey do remise
 release, quit-claim and convey to the said Joseph
 L. Peters all my right title Interest and claim in or
 to the following described real estate, to-wit:
 One undivided One Sixth Interest the same being
 my full and entire Interest which I own or claim
 including my share in the share or Interest owned
 and held by my former husband Robert Nabors in
 or to that certain lot in the town of Columbiana,
 Alabama, called and known as the Nabors lot
 situated on a street running North from the Court
 House in Columbiana, known as Main Street and
 in front of and opposite the residence now owned
 and occupied by Dr. John Williams and said
 lot herein conveyed being bounded as follows, to-wit:
 On the West by said Main Street a distance of
 One hundred and twenty six (126) feet more or less,
 on the South by a lot now owned and occupied
 as a residence by Dr. H. J. Williams a distance
 of One hundred and ninety six (196) feet more or

less on the East by a lot owned by Rev. Francis A. Liles a distance One hundred and Ninety six (196) feet more or less; and on the North by a lot now owned and occupied as a residence by J. W.
