Florence Lester, Martha L. Lester, Charles E. Lester and Ray
B. Lester all being heirs of S. A. Lester deceased; and
Thomas H. Lester Rufus A. Lester and Walter E. Lester as
the executors of the last will and testament of said
S. A. Lester deceased under and by virtue of the power
conferred upon them as such executors in said will

 parcel of land in the N. E. corner of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of
 Section 11, described as follows - beginning at the N. E. corner of
 the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, thence running West along
 North boundary 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains to a stake on said line, thence
 South 10 degrees N. 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ chains to the corner of a log shelter.
 Thence East 15 degrees N. to Eastern boundary to a stake
 in the Spring branch 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains thence W. along Eastern
