and unto his heirs and assigns in fee simple forever,
together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments
and appurtenances rights rents and profits forever and
right of Dower thereunto belonging, and in every way appropriate-

rant and defend the title to the above conveyed premises
to the said party of the second part and to his heirs, represent-
atives and assigns against every lawful claim of our
heirs executors and administrators and no others
