

Notice Dispendus.

To Whom it may Concern: Please take notice that there is now pending in the Chancery Court of Shelby County, Alabama a Cause styled Florence M. Goldard against Robert A. Barry et al which said suit is brought by Florence M. Goldard against Robert A. Barry and Sadie Barry, which suit or Cause is intended to effect the following described real property, to-wit:

A Certain portion or area of land designed for my son, Downey M. Barry by Robert A. Barry said land known as part of the Robert A. Barry land in same County and State. And according to survey made, contains three Hundred acres more or less location fully described as lying Northeast and East, it being a Certain portion or acreage of the Robert A. Barry plantation where he now resides, warranted free from all incumbrances and against any adverse Claims; and the N¹/₂ of the N. N¹/₄ of Section 14, the N. E¹/₄ of Section 11, and all that part of the S¹/₂ of Section 10, lying East of Shoal Creek and South of the Mill Road known as Kelough

Mill Road leading from the Ashville Road to the mill known as the Killough mill. All that part of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 11, lying East of the Ashville Road and all those parts of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of N. $\frac{1}{4}$ and S. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, lying Southeast of a certain lane leading from Ashville Road near the present residence of Marcus A. Denson to Spring Creek, and known as the "Alexander Mill" Road; All in Township 22 South Range 3 West, and known as the Killough Place, situated in Shelby County, Alabama. Take further notice that the purpose of said bill and quit is to set aside a certain conveyance executed by Robert A. Berry to said Sadie Berry, which is recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, purporting to have been dated on the 22nd day of April 1910, and which was filed in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County Ala, for record, on September 19. 1911, and further that said bill seeks to subject said lands to the payment of the debt of Complainant and to enjoin the said Robert A.
