Certificate No / To all to whom These Presents shall come greeting:

21859 Whereas John W. Jones of Shelby County, Alabama has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery, Alabama whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John W. Jones according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "an act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands;" for and the acts supplemental thereto for the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section twenty-eight in Township twenty-four North of Range fifteen East of St. Stephens Meridian in Alabama containing thirty-nine acres and ninety-six hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said John W. Jones Now Know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said John W. Jones and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said John W. Jones and to his heirs and assigns forever.
