 successors and assigns the right to construct operate and maintain
 electric transmission lines and all telegraph and telephone lines towers
 poles and appliances necessary or convenient in connection therewith
 upon a strip of land one hundred feet in width, said strip and the lands
 of which the same is a part being situated in Shelby County Alabama
 and particularly described as follows: of the land of the party of the
 first part being the SW¹/₄ of Sec. 8, T. 24 N., R. 14 East and as the median
 line of said strip is now surveyed and located and more particular-
 ly described as follows to wit: Beginning at a point on the East
 boundary of grantor's land, said point being North 330 feet from the
 S.E. corner of above described quarter section and running thence
 North 54° West a distance of 3282 feet more or less to a point on
 the West boundary of grantor's land, together with all the rights
 and privileges therein necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment
 or use thereof for the purposes above described including the right
 of ingress and egress to and from said strip; and also the right to
 cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstructions
 on said strip and danger trees adjacent thereto where necessary. To have
 and to hold the same to the said Company its successors and as-
 signs forever.
