pany its successors and assigns the right to construct operate
and maintain electric transmission lines and all telegraph
and telephone lines towers, poles and appliances necessary or
convenient in connection therewith upon a strip of land one
hundred feet in width said strip and the lands of which the
same is a part being situated in Shelby County Alabama
and particularly described as follows: Of the lands of the party
of the first part being the South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec-
tion 18 T. 21 S. R. 2 W. and as a median line of the above

described strip is now surveyed and located and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the south boundary of grantors land said point being west 370 feet to the South West Corner of above described land and running north from said point 22°-03" west to northern boundary of grantors land being 790 feet more or less together with all the rights and privileges therein necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof for the purpose above described, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said strip; and also the right to cut and keep down all trees and undergrowth and other obstructions on said strip and danger trees adjacent thereto where necessary.

To have and to hold the same to the said Company its successors and assigns forever.
