For and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars (\$150.00) in hand paid to me by C. L. O'Neal I do hereby grant bargain and sell and convey unto the said C. L. O'Neal for the term of years 1913 1914 and 1915 - all of the timber in the south end of the Northeast Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section 4 Township 22 Range 2 West making in all $26\frac{2}{3}$ Acres also one half of the North West Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section 3 Township 22 Range 2 West making in all fifty six and two-thirds acres ($66\frac{2}{3}$ Acres). It is provided that C. L. O'Neal has the right of entry and exit to and from land on which this timber is situated with all teams wagons and machinery used in the cutting and hauling away of said timber. This Contract is to expire on the first day of January 1916.
