 made a part of this Conveyance, do by these presents grant, bargain,

 side of Post College Street 148 feet more or less West of Main Street
 at the intersection of the - West line of Mrs A. P. Liles lot
 with the East line of the Methodist Parsonage lot and run
 North along said line and along the West line of the lot of
 John H. Johnson about eighty-two (82) feet to the open West
 corner of the present Court house lot, hence continue North
 along the West line of said Court house lot about forty (40)
 feet to the South East corner of the said Presbyterian Church

Brown and unanimously adopted by all the members of the congregation present to-wit: W. B. Brown, J. G. Leiper, Henry Milner, Mrs. J. H. M. Page, H. R. A. Milner, Mrs. J. S. Pitt, Mrs. Etta McMillan, Mrs. Henry Milner, Miss C. A. Leiper.

Be it resolved by the Congregation of the Columbian Presbyterian Church, assembled in said Church on this the 24th day of February 1913 that we, the said Congregation accept the offer of Mr. J. Horsley to buy a portion of the Church lot in said town of Columbian to-wit: Beginning at a point on the North side of West College Street 148 feet more or less from Main Street, at the intersection of the front line of Mrs. A. B. Liles lot with the East line of the Methodist Parsonage lot and run North along said lot line and along the West line of the lot of John P. Johnson about 82 feet to the South West corner of the present Court house lot, thence Centene North along the West line of said Court house lot about 40 feet to the South East corner of the Presbyterian Church lot for a point of beginning; thence running West along the South line of the Presbyterian Church lot 32 feet thence North and parallel with the East line of said Church lot 16 feet, thence East and parallel with the South line of said Church lot 32 feet to the East line of said Church lot, thence South along the East line of said Church lot 16 feet to the point of beginning.
