In the matter of the petition of W. J. McCall
father and guardian of A. A. McCall to remove the disabilities
of non-age of said A. A. McCall.

This cause having been reset for hearing on the 10th day
of February 1913, and regularly continued to this date, and
having been submitted for decree on the petition as amended
and ex parte affidavits of W. J. McCall, John Baker and Sam
Elliott, and it appearing that a copy of the petition as
amended was duly served upon the said minor by the
Sheriff of this County, on to-wit, the 22nd day of January
1913, and that notice of the filing of said petition and of
the date set for the hearing was duly given by the clerk
of this Court by publication for three successive weeks pre-
ceding the date fixed for the hearing, and it further ap-
pearing to the satisfaction of the Court that it will be to the
interest of said minor to have his disabilities removed
It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court
that said A. A. McCall, who is over the age of eighteen
years, he and he hereby is relieved of the disabilities of
non-age, and that he he and he hereby is vested with the
power to sue and be sued to contract and be contracted
with, to receive and take possession of any real and per-
sonal property to which he may be entitled, to purchase
sell and convey real and personal property and to do
all things and to all intents and purposes as effectually
as if he was twenty-one years of age, except and
it is hereby provided that this decree shall not author-
ize nor have the effect to validate any acquaintance
or contract with the said guardian, W. J. McCall, on
the part of said minor A. A. McCall, until there shall
be a final settlement of said guardianship in the Probate
Court where the same is pending according to law.
It is further ordered that a certified copy of this decree
be filed for record and recorded in the office of
the Probate Judge of Shelby County, and in the office
of the Probate Judge of any and every County in this
State to which said minor may remove or in which
he may make any contract or do any business during

his minority. It is further hereby decreed that the petitioner
 W. J. McCall pay the costs of this proceeding for which an
 execution may issue.
