

This Indenture made and entered into this the 18th day of February, 1897, by and between The Southern Building and Loan Association a Corporation organized under the laws of the State of Alabama, with its principal place of business in the City of Huntsville in said State of the one part and Jacob C. McElroy of the County of Shelby, State of Alabama of the other part:

Witnesseth: that the said The Southern Building and Loan Association a Corporation as aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of two hundred and ninety (290) Dollars to it in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath this day given, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents doth release, relinquish, quit-claim and convey its entire right, title and interest unto the said Jacob C. McElroy in and to the following described lot or parcel of land situated in the town of Calera, County of Shelby, State of Alabama to-wit: Lot number four hundred and seven and the south half of Lot number four hundred and six, according to Davis' plat made in 1869, situated on Montgomery Avenue and Patton streets, fronting ninety (90) feet on said Avenue, and running back 138 feet on Patton Street, now known as Church Street. To have and to hold the above described lot or parcel of land, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, unto the said Jacob C. McElroy his heirs and assigns forever.
