

The State of Alabama, J.D. McLendon and Rosa McLendon his wife
County of Shelby, S.D. said County and State in consideration
of the sum of Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars paid by the Alabama Power
Company a Corporation, receipt whereof is acknowledged do
hereby grant to said Company its successors and assigns
the right to construct, operate and maintain electric trans-
mission lines and all telegraph and telephone lines, towers,
poles and appliances necessary or convenient in connection
therewith upon a strip of land one hundred feet in width said
strip and the lands of which the same is a part being
situated in Shelby County, Alabama and particularly de-
scribed as follows, of the lands of the party of the first part
being the 1/8th of the 8th Sec. of T. 20 S. R. 9 W. and as the

median line of said strip is now surveyed and located and more particularly described as follows to wit; Beginning at a point on the South boundary of grantor's land said point being west 265 ft. from the S.E. corner of the above described quarter of quarter acre and running thence North 34 degrees 51 minutes west to the north boundary of grantor's land. Together with all the rights and privileges thereof necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, for the purposes above described, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said strip; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstruction on said strip and danger trees adjacent thereto where necessary. To have and to hold to the said lessee and his successors and assigns forever.
