 Shelby County Alabama and particularly described as follows:
 The lands of the party of the first part being the Nth of the S^E
 in Sec. 4 T. 820 S. R. 3 Mth and as the median line of said strip
 of land is now surveyed and located and more particularly
 described as follows to wit: Beginning at a point on the north
 boundary of grantor's land, said point being 512 feet from
 the center of above described Sec. and running thence South
 34 degrees and 51 minutes East to a point on the south boundary
 of grantor's land, together with all the rights and privileges
 therein necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof
 for the purposes above described including the right of ingress
 and egress to and from said strip, and also the right to cut and
 keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstruction on said
 strip and dangerous trees adjacent thereto where necessary, to have
 and to hold the same to the said company its successors and
 assigns forever.
