

The State of Alabama, Know all men by these Presents, That whereas  
 The County of Dallas, William M. Meager, deceased, by his last  
 will and testament did direct that immediately after the probate  
 of said will that L. J. Sidney Robbins, as Executor thereof, should  
 divide his Estate, real and personal, into five parts, equal in  
 my opinion and that his four children should draw by lot each  
 for his or her part, and whereas as said will of William M.  
 Meager, deceased, was duly probated in the Probate Court of  
 Dallas County, Alabama on August 20th, 1898 and as Executor  
 as aforesaid, did proceed immediately to divide the real  
 or personal property of said Estate into five parts, equal  
 in my opinion and did number said parts 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5  
 respectively, and the five children of said William M.  
 Meager to-wit: Mrs Annie P. Gaskin, Mrs Clara M. Bassett,  
 Modicia M. Robbins, Miss Rosalie P. Gaskin and H. M. Moore  
 did draw by lot each for his or her part: and  
Whereas said Mrs Annie P. Gaskin did draw for herself  
 and for her children by lot one of said parts embracing  
 and including the following described property, to-wit:  
 the real estate in Marengo County Alabama, described as  
 follows: The South east quarter of the North east quarter of  
 Section twenty-eight: the East half of the South East quarter of  
 Section Twenty-eight: the West half of the South West quarter  
 of Section Twenty-seven: the East half of the North east quarter  
 of Section Thirty-three, the West half of the North West quarter of  
 Section Thirty-four, all in Township seventeen, Range five  
 East. Also the land in Shelby County, Alabama described as  
 follows to-wit:

 Convey unto the said, Mrs Annie P. Foster and her chil-  
 dren who so far as they are now in being are named  
 as follows; - Lucia F. Foster, Hartwell H. Foster, William  
 B. Foster, Benjamin M. Foster and Rose M. Foster, their  
 heirs and assigns all the estate right title and interest  
 which the estate of said William M. Meador deceased  
 has in and to the above described real and personal  
 property, together with all and singular the documents,  
 hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or  
 in any wise appertaining or in any wise opportunity  
 to have and to hold unto the said Mrs Annie P. Foster  
 and her children as provided by and under the terms of  
 the said will of the said William M. Meador, as fully  
 and completely as I am authorized in and by the  
 promises to Convey the same.


