Dollars, paid by the Alabama Power Company, a Corpora-
tion, receipt whereof is acknowledged do hereby grant to
said Company, its successors and assigns the right to
Construct, operate and maintain electric transmission
lines and all telegraph and telephone lines, towers,
poles and appliances necessary or convenient in con-
nection therewith, upon a strip of land one hundred feet
in width, said strip and the lands of which the same
is a part being situated in Shelby County, Alabama and
particularly described as follows; said strip is a part of
the North East Quarter of the Northwest Quarter and the
North West Quarter of the North East Quarter Section 24,
Twpship 17 South, Range 1 East, and the median line

of said strip is more particularly described as follows:—
 Beginning at a point on the East boundary line of the North East
 Quarter of the North West Quarter, Section 24, Township 17 South,
 Range 1 East, South 169 feet from the North East corner thereof,
 running thence from said point of beginning, South 81 degrees
 and 56 minutes West to a point on the West boundary, also
 beginning at a point on the West boundary of the N.W.^{1/4} of the
 North East Quarter, Section 24, Tp 17 South, Range 1 East, South
 169 feet from the North West corner thereof, running hence
 from said point of beginning, North 81 degrees and 56 minutes
 East to a point on the North boundary of said land, it
 being the intention of the Grantor to grant such rights a-
 cross said lands, according to the final location survey of
 said strip heretofore made by the said Alabama Power Company,
 together with all the rights and privileges therein necessary
 or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, for
 the purposes alone described, including the right of
 ingress and egress to and from said strip, and also
 the right to cut and keep clear all trees and under-
 growth and other obstruction on said strip, and dan-
 gerous adjacent thereto where necessary, so here and
 to hold the same to the said Company, its successors
 and assigns forever.
