 hundred Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party
 of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
 knowledged, the said parties of the first part have bargained
 and sold, and do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell
 and convey, unto the said party of the second part,
 the following described real estate lying in the county of
 Shelby, State of Alabama, to-wit: NE 1/4 & SE 1/4 of NW 1/4
 & E 1/2 of SW 1/4 & N 1/2 of SE 1/2 & NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 Section
 23, Township 20, R 1 E. and N 1/2 of NW 1/4 & N 1/2 of S 1/2
 of NW 1/4 & N 1/2 of W 1/2 of NE 1/4 Section 26 Township
 20 Range 1 East.

To Have and To Hold to the said party of the second part,
 and to his heirs and assigns forever. and said parties
 of the first part covenant with the said Columbus W.
 O'Hara of the second part, that they are lawfully seized
 in fee simple of said premises; that they are free
 from all incumbrances, and that they have a good right
 to sell and convey the same; that they will and their

 defend the same to said Columbus W. O'Hara of the second
