To have and to hold unto said second party heirs and assigns forever the above described and hereby granted lands and premises and the parties of the first part husband and wife hereby convey said land and hereby covenant with the said parties of the second part to that they are lawfully seized of, have a good right to sell and convey the said land and hereby bind themselves their heirs and legal representative forever warrant and defend the title to said land and premises to the said party of the second part their heirs, agents and legal representative ever against the claims of all and every person in law or equity and against the government of the United States.
