A Certain tract or lot of land situated in the town of Montevallo, Alab. described as follows: Commencing at the south corner of the lower house now occupied by Darius J. Morgan Co. on Main Street and running along said Main Street in front directly clear for a distance of Twenty-five (25) feet, thence up the North Westly direction to a building, top main street, for a distance of Two Hundred (200) feet, thence for a North Eastly direction parallel to Main Street for a distance of Twenty-five (25) feet, thence direct to Main Street for a distance of Two hundred feet to place of beginning.
