To have and to hold the aforementioned premises to the said Hardy Crim his heirs and assigns to their use and behoof forever and I do covenant with the said Hardy Crim his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforementioned premises, that they are free from all encumbrances, that I have a good right to sell and convey the same to the said Hardy Crim his heirs and assigns and that I will warrant and defend the premises to the said Hardy Crim his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
